

Before Starting the Project Listings for the CoC Priority Listing

The CoC Consolidated Application requires TWO submissions. Both this Project Priority Listing AND the CoC Application MUST be completed and submitted prior to the CoC Program Competition submission deadline stated in the NOFO.

Things to Remember:

On 7/8/2024, the project applicant notified the project operator via email that EXCL PSH 0475 will be accepted in the FY24 Community CoC Application and Priority List, but reduced by \$267,962. This reduction was in accordance with the "CoC Expenditure Threshold Policy and Procedure for Renewal Grant" due to recapture of funding in the last four consecutive years.

On 9/5/2024, the project applicant notified the project operator via email that the project was further reduced by \$991,725 as a result of the OH-500 CoC Annual Community Prioritization Event, for a total reduction amount of \$1,259,687.


